DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
Dosage and Administration

To avoid underdosing and ensure the worming treatment is effective, it is essential to weigh your cat accurately and dose according to bodyweight. Each 2.5mL syringe of EXELPET All-Wormer Paste for Cats and Kittens will treat an average Australian cat weighing 5kg. For cats and kittens less than 5kg, give 1mL (one graduation on the syringe) per 2kg bodyweight. For cats over 5kg give one whole syringe plus an additional 1mL for every 2kg in bodyweight over 5kg.

Dosing Tips

To worm your cat, place the syringe nozzle between the back teeth, as far back on the tongue as possible. Carefully depress the syringe plunger to give the correct dose. Alternatively, the paste may be mixed with food. Some cats may salivate after treatment.

Treatment Frequency

Cats can be reinfested with worms from other pets or from their surroundings, therefore treatment should be repeated regularly. Follow the treatment frequency recommendations in the table below and worm all your pets at the same time to maximise protection.

Kittens up to 12 Weeks of Age	Kittens & Cats From 12 Weeks of Age	Pregnant Cats
Treat at 6, 8 and 12 weeks of age for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Roundworm • Hookworm 	Treat every 3 months for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Roundworm • Hookworm • Tapeworm 	Treat at mating, before birth of kittens and then every 3 months

If worm problems persist, consult a veterinarian.

Important Information

1. To accurately find your cat's weight, firstly weigh yourself, then weigh yourself holding your cat. Your cat's weight is your weight subtracted from the combined weight.
2. To minimise re-infestation of your cat with intestinal worms, treat all cats and dogs in the household at the same time.
3. Cats are frequently infested by fleas, which are the intermediate hosts (carriers) of tapeworm (*Dipylidium caninum*). To provide complete protection for your cat an integrated flea control programme should also be implemented.
4. Always maintain a high standard of hygiene when disposing of your cats droppings.
