Do not wash your cat after treatment.

**General Instructions**

**Before fleas are seen on your cat** – Apply **EXELPET Spot-On Flea Control for Cats and Kittens** and continue all year round for the best results.

**When your cat already has fleas** – This product does not kill adult fleas. Therefore, cats already infested with fleas should be initially treated with **EXELPET CAPSTAR™**. Treat your cat with **EXELPET Spot-On Flea Control for Cats and Kittens** for on going protection. Treatment with **EXELPET Spot-On Flea Control for Cats and Kittens** should be continued every 3 months throughout the year. If your cat becomes reinfested with adult fleas use **EXELPET CAPSTAR™**.
