## For the treatment and control of:

Roundworm (Toxocara cati, Toxascaris leonina) kills larval (L4), immature and adult worms. Hookworm (Ancylostoma tubaeforme, Ancylostoma braziliense [this hookworm is usually restricted to tropical areas in Australia], Uncinaria stenocephala), kills larval (L4), immature and adult worms of all species.

Ear mites (Otodectes cynotis):

Lungworm (Aelurostrongylus abstrusus) in cats.

One application lasts for a month. Water resistant formulation

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Use with caution in sick, debilitated or underweight animals. This product may be safely applied to heartworm infected cats. However a diagnostic test for heartworm prior to commencement of treatment is recommended to ensure the optimum health of cats. Take care to avoid the product coming into contact with the eyes or mouth of the animal. Ingestion by the recipient or in-contact animals should be prevented. The liquid vehicle in this product may discolour or damage certain surfaces and fabrics e.g polished floorboards, leather etc. Exclude the animal from contact with such surfaces until the product dries on the

Side Effects: Occasionally hair loss may occur at the application site. This is usually a single occurrence and hair will grow back uneventfully.

Dosage and Administration: For external use only Do not give product by mouth One tube treats cats over 4kg bodyweight

Application:

Hold tube uprojeth and pull off the cap. Reverse the cap and push cap back on tube. Twist cap to break seal, then remove cap from tube. Apply on the back of the head. The animal should be standing for easy application. Remove any collar prior to application and replace when product is dry. Part the hair until the skin is visible. Rearche the jot of the tube on the skin and squeeze the tube firmly twice to apply the solution directly on the skin. Avoid pet's eyes or mouth.









repeat montry or as arrecture. This product tremains efficacious following shampoo treatment, swimming or exposure to rain. If washing anima during use of this product use a soap free shampbo. Treatment for heartworm should occur regularly at monthly intervals.

FLEACONTROL AND PREVENTION:
Ineatment of pers with this product rapidly kills fleas and reduces the incidence of flea allergy dermatitis (FAD). This product may be used as the only products for flea control as it breaks the fife cycle and kills fleas emerging from the environment. More rapid resolution of heavy environmental infersations may be obtained by additional environmental control measures using a suitable registered product.

HEARTWORM PREVENTION Treatment with this product should start one month before the first exposure to mosquitoes and must be applied at one incontily intervals to maintain continuous year-round protection. When regiscing another heartworm preventive product, the first treatment with this product must be given within one month of the last dose of the previous product.

WORM CONTROL This product treats and controls the major gastrointestinal nematodes of cats but does not control tapeworms. In order to control tapeworms use EXELPET "Vet Series" Spot-On All-Wormer for Cats. If worm problems persist, consult a veterinarian.

TREATMENT AND CONTROL OF EAR MITES for the treatment of ear mites (Otodectes cynotis), this product is highly efficacious as a single dose Monthly application will control any subsequent ear miter interation. To maximize efficacy through cleaning of the ear canal is recommended with a product that is registered for that purpose or adherend by a veterinarian.

TREATMENT AND CONTROL OF LUNCWORM For the treatment of lungworm (Aelurostrongylus abstruss), this product is highly efficacious as a single dose. Monthly application will control any subsequent Lungworm infection.

KITTENS may be treated with this product from 9 weeks of age.

For control of roundworms and hookworms kittens require worming at 6 and 8 weeks age. When worming kittens prior to commencing use a specific worming agent such as age. When worming kittens prior to commencing use a specific worming age to socious EXELPET" VetSeries "Spot-On All-Wormer for Cats. Once treatment with this product is commenced every month, worms will be continuously controlled.

PREGNANCY AND LACTATION No primary embryo-toxic, teratogenic or reproductive toxic effects have been observed with imidacloprid or moxidectir in laboratory species. Evidence suggest that no adverse effects are to be expected in pregnant and lactating cats. However, the safety of this product has not been established during pregnancy and lactation.
